The Common Norms Committee (CNC), in its 8th meeting held on 13.11.2020, had decided for granting of 1-2% as Covid allowance for sanitation requirements post COVID-19. Further to arrive at the exact figure, the CNC had also decided that MSDE would examine the report of SSDM, Odisha.

- 2. This matter has been examined and it has been decided that 1.5% of the average training cost per trainee for 3 months, or 1.5% of the hourly base cost rate (as applicable as per category of trade undergoing the training) may be allowed as Covid Allowance. The Covid allowance would be funded out of the grants already made available for training, and no additional funds can be demanded for incurring the expenditure. This allowance should be discontinued once the need ceases.
